


## Aviso para os usuarios de Proquest:


Para migrar as alertas os pasos a seguir dende a nova plataforma son os seguintes:

### 1 Seleccionar My Research,



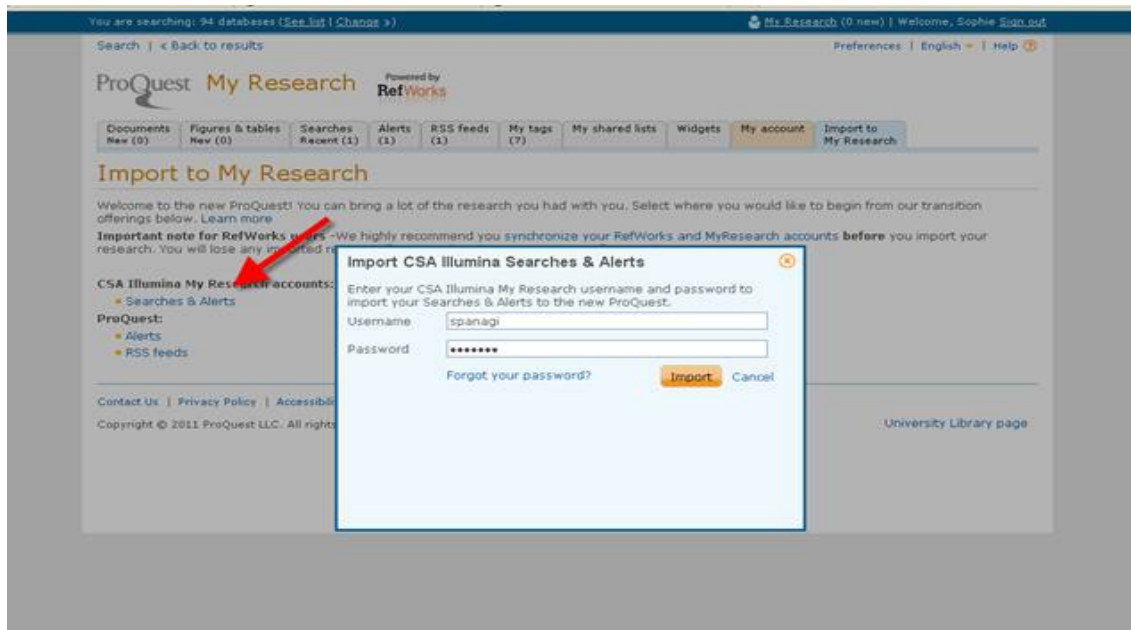
